SEEREN2 Inauguration event in Belgrade

December 6th, 2006

SEEREN2 inauguration event that took place on the 6th of December at University of Belgrade demonstrated the significance of improving cross border links between AMRES and other SEEREN2 countries.

As part of the FP6 SEEREN2 project, AMRES has established two Internet links towards GEANT - the increased SEEREN1 link towards GRNET from 34 Mbps to 155 Mbps and an optical link of 1Gbps capacity towards HUNGARNET - the first cross border optical link between two NREN's in South-Eastern Europe.

On the basis of cross border and internal dark fibre infrastructure, AMRES central node has become a potential regional node for connecting other nearby countries.

Keynote speakers at this event included Mr. Ulf Dahlsten, Director of Emerging technologies and infrastructures in the European Commission; Aleksandar Popovic, Minister of Science and Environmental Protection of Republic of Serbia; Vasilis Maglaris, Chairman of NREN-PC; Panagiotis Tsanakas and Lajos Balint, Presidents of GRNET and HUNGARNET; Yannis Mitsos, SEEREN2 project coordinator, Zoran Jovanovic, Director of Belgrade University Computing Centre, etc.
